

Physical Education: Fifteen semester hours credit in physical education, ten hours of which must be in the field of health, physiology, first aid, or school hygiene.

Librarian: High school librarians shall have academic qualifications equivalent to those required of teachers in class "A" high schools, and these qualifications shall include not fewer than eight semester hours of college credit in library science. (Effective September 1, 1943).

CLASS "B" TEACHER PREPARATION

A class "B" rank will be granted those schools that meet the school standards satisfactorily, and whose teachers shall each have not less than twelve college hours of preparation in the subject matter field, and who shall have at least five college hours in the specific subject preparation with such limitations and exemptions as apply to class "A" schools. This regulation is to become effective on and after September 1, 1940.

CLASS "C" TEACHER PREPARATION

A class "C" rank will be given schools that meet the school standards satisfactorily, and whose teachers shall each have not less than eight college hours of preparation in the subject matter field and who shall have at least three college hours in the specific subject taught. Not to exceed two college hours may be deducted from the subject matter field for credit earned in high school. This regulation is to become effective on and after September 1, 1940.
