Minors for Physical Education majors:

- (1) English (English Language and literature, Speech and Dramatic Arts, and Journalism) 5 hours Rhetoric, at least 10 hours in one of the departments named. The remainder in any of the departments named.
- (2) Foreign Language (Ancient Languages, Germanic languages, Hispanic languages, Romance languages) 20 hours in some one department, but may be reduced to minimum of 10 hours by high school work in the given department, counted at the rate of 5 hours per high school unit. Remainder in any one language.
- (3) Mathematics (Mathematics) 15 hours in mathematics in addition to two units in high school work in mathematics. 5 hours in mathematics, ? physics, chemistry or geology.
- (4) Biological Sciences (Bacteriology, Botany, Entomology, Physiology, Zoology, Anatomy) 20 hours aggregate from any of the departments named. Maximum 5 hours Physical Science may be presented.
- (5) Physical Science (Chemistry, Geology, Mineralogy, Physics and Astronomy)
 20 hours aggregate from any of the departments named. Maximum
 of 5 hours biological sciences may be presented.
- (6) Social Sciences (Economics, History, Political Science, Sociology) At

 (5 or 10?) least 10 hours history and 5 hours political science. The remainder in one of the departments named.
- (7) Sociology (Economics, History, Political Science, Sociology) At least 10 hours in Sociology, 5 hours of history. The remainder in one of the departments named.
- (8) Philosophy and Psychology (Philosophy and Psychology) At least 10 hours in (Omit Philosophy?) Philosophy and Psychology. The remainder in Economics, political science, and sociology, or in zoology, anatomy and physiology.
 - (9) Home Economics 20 hours in Home Economics. May be reduced to minimum of 15 hours by high school work in Home Economics counted at rate of 5 hours per high school unit.
 - (10) Fine Arts (Music, Drawing and Art) 20 hours in Fine Arts department.

 Not more than 8 hours in private lessons for development of technical skill.
 - (11) Commerce Satisfactory proficiency in stenography, typewriting and computation.

 20 hours in the department of Economics. Not less than 5 hours being from each of the following 3 fields: General Economics, Business Administration, and Accounting.
 - (12) Journalism 5 hours Rhetoric, 10 hours Journalism; 5 hours in Economics, Sociology or Political Science.
