Special responsibilities of the administrator in initiating and directing curriculum construction; administrative set-up, methods, procedures and costs of operation of temporary and continuous programs; special problems involved in organizing both the integrated and subject matter types of curricula; techniques for evaluation and appraisal of procedures; organization of state and local programs. Prerequisites: 15 hours of education.

- (4) That the title and description of S399 be changed to the following:

S399 Research in Curriculum Construction---
Two to eight hours of credit. The work of this course consists of intensive and independent work done under the general direction of the instructor in charge. To secure credit in this course the results of the study must, save in the case of candidates for the degree of Master of Education, be presented in the form of an acceptable thesis. Prerequisites: S292 and either S293 or S294.

- (5) That the college be advised of the desirability of their giving credit for S292 instead of B262 as is now the case.
