Dear Friends:

Dean Schwegler has asked that we offer for the 60-hour certificate two new courses - "Personal Hygiene and Community Health", 3 hours, for the freshmen, fall semester; and "Playground Activities for the Elementary School". This second course is to be on the elementary school level. He suggests that we offer it for the freshmen, in the spring semester.

At a meeting of the Executive Council of the Kansas Health and Physical Education Association held at McPherson last Saturday I learned that Kansas State College and the teachers colleges of Kansas are offering "Personal Hygiene and Community Health" for 3 hours credit, and "Elementary School Playground Activities" for 2 hours credit.

Dean Schwegler spoke to me last week concerning the matter of our group offering this latter course for 3 hours credit. My opinion is that this course should be a 2 hour course to conform with our state college offering. A committee has been appointed and these courses in the various state schools will be synchronized. I am taking the matter up with Dean Schwegler, and he doubtless will agree that the latter course should be 2 hours.

I would like for you people to meet in my office some time in the near future, but I wanted to appraise you of the fact so that you might be thinking what would be the best offering.
