Some of my boys called my attention to reports of a story out of Lincoln that one of the tall defensive players on the Nebrasia team batted the ball every from the basket in a recent game played up there. After Wellhausen's performance last year the rules committee, under Rule 14, Sections 15 and 14, made the following provision:

Soc. 13. Interfere with the ball or basket while the ball is on the edge of or within the basket.

PERATET -

(a) If committed at OFFORENTS' BASKET, shall be declared a goal whother made or not. (Ball put in play as after a field goal.)

(b) If committed at player's ONE BASKET, shall be declared no goal whether made or not. (Jump ball at measur free throw line.)

nors ander (b) an offensive player shall not be decred to have interfored with the ball on a try for goal from the field unless be touched the bashet or any part thereof.

Sec. 14. Touch the ball with the head or arm while that hand or arm is touching any part of the opponents' basket, or while that hand or arm is above the opponents' basket.

note...Above the backet as used in this section means any part of the state of the backet as its base and extending percenticularly upward.

Shall be declared a goal whether made or not. (Ball put in play as after a field goal.)
