

SECTION #3. As a general rule and unless important reasons oppose, major intersectional games shall be considered of first importance and be given priority over others.

SECTION 4. (a) For football, one Referee, one Umpire, one Head Linesman, and one Field Judge shall be appointed to each varsity football game scheduled by Member Institutions.

(b) For basketball, two officials, one to be designated as the Referee, the other as the Umpire, shall be appointed to each varsity basketball game scheduled by Member Institutions.

(c) For varsity games between two Member Institutions, the Commissioner shall appoint officials whose names appear on the current Preferential List(s) for football and basketball of each contesting Member Institution.

(d) For varsity football games between a Member Institution and a non-member institution, two officials selected by the Commissioner from the Preferential List of the Member Institutions concerned, existing contracts permitting, and two officials selected by the Commissioner from a list of at least eight officials proposed by the Non-Member Institution shall be appointed.

(e) For varsity basketball games between a Member Institution and a Non-Member Institution, as far as it is practicable, the same principles as set forth in (d) above shall apply to the appointment of basketball officials.

SECTION 5. (a) To equalize the possible varying preferences of the two contesting Member Institutions in any one game, each such Member Institution's ranking of the four football officials appointed shall be totaled separately and the totals so derived shall be as nearly equal as it is possible for the Commissioner to make them.

(b) As far as it is practicable, the same procedure as outlined in the above shall apply to appointment of basketball officials.

NOTE: The ranking of each official by a Member Institution shall be determined by the numerical position of that official's name on the current Preferential List of the Member Institution concerned.

SECTION 6. At the close of each season for both football and basketball, the qualifying score for each official shall be computed by the Commissioner.

SECTION 7. (a) For football games reported to the Office of the Commissioner after the close of any football season and before the 1st day of January next following, officials shall be appointed and notices to Member Institutions and to the officials concerned shall be mailed on or before February 15th next following.

(b) For basketball games reported to the office of the Commissioner after the close of any basketball season and before the 15th day of April of that year, officials shall be appointed and notices to Member Institutions and to the officials concerned shall be mailed on or before May 15 of that year.

SECTION 8. (a) To equalize the possible varying preferences of the two contesting Member Institutions in any one game, each such Member Institution's ranking of the four football officials appointed shall be totaled separately and the totals so derived shall be as nearly
