RANKING

An official's Ranking Numerical position on the list shall be determined by his Qualifying Score.

CLASSIFICATION

Officials shall be classed as "A", "B", or "C".

A minimum qualifying score shall be fixed for each classification annually by the Commissioner.

Class A computes in all 16 events - Total points 117
Class B computes in 12 events - not in No. 7 Fearlessness, No. 8,
Desirability, No. 10 Elapsed Time, and No. 12 Program Conferences - Total Points 92.
Class C includes all others.
