Dear Mr. Eubank:

Answering your letter of November 24th, I beg to state that this year we are offering for the first time a four-year curriculum in Physical Education. We have not yet worked out a specific curriculum for the training of playground and recreational directors.

However, we do offer a course called Principles of Community Recreation, which is elective for students majoring in Physical Education. This course is planned for students interested in recreational leadership, in playgrounds, community and recreational organizations and activities of clubs, and in the organization, management and equipment of conducting social activities with adult groups in community recreation centers.

I am enclosing a mimeographed copy of a radio broadcast given recently over our University station, KFKU, which outlines some of the purposes and aims of our new department. I thought you might be interested in reading it.
