

It is true that I have delayed somewhat in answering your courteous letter, but on the other hand I have the pleasure of writing you on the date that will be historic of the inauguration of the Conference of Rio de Janeiro. I must thank you for sending the details concerning the training school (school for trainers). In return I am sending you in this same mail recently published notes on "Goal-Hi" in an Argentine magazine and in a program or of the Sacred Family College, one of the most important Catholic colleges in our country. I am including also a photograph taken at one of our most important bathing resorts of the Atlantic. I inform you also that the National Commission of Physical Education has already prepared the Spanish edition of rules and the inclusion of the 4th course of teaching the game to professors of physical education of our country which will be initiated next March.
