But I wanted to ask you about your "Goal-Hi" game, which I saw described in the Farm Journal and Farmer's Wife, November, 1940. Not enough of the details of the post are given in this short article.

Will you please tell me what is the thickness of the 18-inch ring, also of the curved braces (3), and especially their length? What are the dimensions of the cones (3) at the base forming the three-way chute? What are their thicknesses? What material made of? How are they fastened together? How fastened at the base? What is the depth from the center of the ring to the juncture of the cone-chutes? What are the dimensions of the swinging gates (3)? Their material? How fastened on the 18-inch ring? What is the full height from floor to top of ring?

If the apparatus can be made by a blacksmith we would like to make one for the boys and girls of our church to use.

Perhaps you can tell me where I may buy one of these posts, the price, and etc. if we cannot make one. Any literature describing the measurements, the game, you have, I would be glad to pay for.
