Dear Dr. Allen:

I then pulled my center and shifted him to a guard, and shifted the other guard to center. The thing worked out perfectly. The forward on this other team scored a fast basket right in the beginning of the game, and from that point on was held scoreless while my own captain, playing a guard position for the first time in his life, scored seven baskets and four fouls.
