Dear Maurice:

Thanks for the check of \$20.65 in your letter of July 15.

It is better that I have the Goal-Hi here for you on account of several factors. It would not be possible to ship the Goal-Hi to you as an individual because Medarts are very particular about handling them through their dealers. However, I will have it here, disassembled for you, and you can put it in your car in this form very nicely. While it looks like quite an apparatus, the Medart people assemble them in an uncanny fashion and you will have no difficulty in hauling it in the car. I will explain the details to you when you come to Lawrence.

Please write me ahead of time, two or three days, and let me know when you will be here; and also the time, so that I will have the Goal-Hi all ready for you, wrapped in such a way that it will not injure your car. When you come to take your second treatment from Dr. Owen, or another treatment, let me know and we can work this in the schedule so that you can haul it back without making a special trip.

I am sure that you will find the treatment very beneficial and I know that you want the Goal-Hi as soon as possible. So anytime that you drive over we will have it waiting for you. I am anxious the boys have it.
