Each jumper shall stand with both feet in the area inside the 15 foot radius circle. The Referee shall then toss the ball upward between the two jumping players, to a height greater than either of them can jump and so that it will drop between them. - Continue in book as is -

Sec. 5 - The jumping players must not tap the ball before it reaches its highest point. Neither jumper may tap the ball more than three times, after which neither may touch ~~get at~~ the ball again until it has touched one of the other eight players, the floor, ~~the~~ ^{the} ground, or the basket. Under this provision four taps are possible, two by each jumper. When a jump ball takes place in the (fifteen foot 15') radius circle, all players ^{except} the jumpers shall remain outside of the fifteen foot radius circle and inside the larger peripheral circle bounding the 15 foot radius circle until the ball has been tapped.

Infraction of this clause, ~~is normally a violation~~ is normally a violation (award of ball to opponents out of bounds) but repeated infraction may be penalized as delay of the game.
