ferred to in section (b), the remainder shall be distributed equally among the members of the association whether they are represented by teams or not.

- (2) If the gross receipts are not sufficient to meet the expenses referred to in section (b), the deficit shall be prorated according to the number of men representing each institution that has a team participating.
- 8. Track.
- a: Five places shall be scored in the outdoor meet and four places in the indoor meet.
- b. Each team may start as many men in the individual events as places are to be scored, but only one relay team in a relay event.
 - 9. Swimming.
 - a. Four places shall be scored.
 - b. Each team may start four men in each individual event and one team in each relay.

XIX. PRIZES. The following prizes shall be purchased by the secretary from association funds:

1. Outdoor and Indoor track:

First place team trophy.

First place trophy for the relay.

Gold, silver, gold bronze and bronze medals for first, second, third, and fourth in individual events.

Gold medals for the members of the winning relay team.

2. Two Mile Team Race.

First place team trophy.

Gold medal for first place.

Silver medals for second, third and fourth places.

Bronze medals for fifth and sixth places.

(Places to be determined by the number of points scored in round robin duals.)

3. Wrestling.

First place team trophy.

Gold and silver medals for first and second places in each weight.

Places to be determined by the number of points
