I have never tried to pick an All-American team. I might mention, however, that we have Ralph Miller who might be on some selections, and a sophomore, Charlie Black, who is a little too young for that at the present time. Ralph Miller has all the earmarks of qualifying for that position. He is the leading scorer in the Big Six Conference, with an average of 14.6 points a game, and Charlie Black is second, with an average of 13.6. Miller was a star football player and attracted national recognition by his playing last fall. He is a graduate of Chanute, Kansas, high school.
