I am sending you a copy of a speech that I made to the Cape Girardeau, Missouri, Teachers College, and the Central High School players of that city on November 26, 1941. My purpose has been to tell the truth to these high school and college players regarding the real status of big time commercialized football. There is so much publicity about its grandour that many boys follow wandering fires lost in the quagmire, and then they wake up and find that it is the bunk rather than the grand and glorious achievement that they thought it was. Football is fine if you get a diploma, but it is a disappointment without one.
