So, whether you go back to the crusades or bring yourself up to the present, the ideal of the men going to war still has a potent ring.

Bob, you and I, of course, will go the way of all flesh, and if you can think of life through the hundreds and thousands of years - that life has been repeating itself - then you will get a true perspective and will be able to do in the short while that you are here the very best that you can. Before the Nazis defiled the swastika it had a beautiful Indian legend. That emblem stood for kindness and reverence, and the motto was "May the four winds of Heaven ever upon you gently blow." Here's my wish for you, Bob. And may you have a philosophy equal to the occasion.
