I was indeed sorry to learn through the Kansas City Star last evening that K. U. will lose the services of Assistant Coach Pressnell to our old rival, M. U.

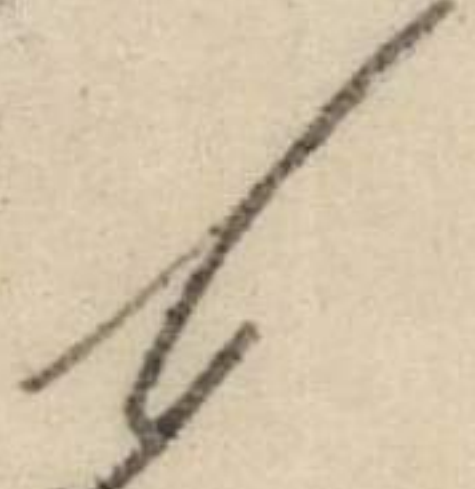
I happen to have three children attending K. U. at this time, but have been for many years past a stanch supporter and rooter for K. U. athletics in general.
