


Dear Mr. Allen:



My athletic experience was gained at Pleasantville High School and New York University, participating in football, basketball, baseball and ice hockey.


While in the Metropolitan Area in New York State during 1932--1939, I officiated for High Schools and Semi-Pro at football, basketball, and baseball games.
