The following is tabulated information contained in the questionnaire study involving intramural athletics for boys in high schools. While the material no doubt contains much pertinent information which can be gained from it by further study, no attempt has been made to evaluate the finding or to comment regarding them. It is hoped that the more complete study will be published shortly. We are deeply indebted to those who took the time to fill out and return the questionnaires. The large amount of additional material and numerous suggestions have indeed been helpful. For convenience in tabulating the schools were divided into five groups according to enrollment. The smallest enrollment listed was fifty-seven and the largest was seventy-eight hundred.
