If you think it would help for me to look up the data and present it to Karl Klooz I would be glad to do it. The Athletic Board is not hidebound here, nor do they have hyper-athletic tendencies, and I believe they might consider the case.

I am wondering just how well you remember Don Isett and if you feel that you could write a good strong letter recommending him - not so much on his athletic ability, but the type of fellow he was on the squad and the type of competitor. I can remember that he was a pretty good little quarter miler; in fact, a dickens of a fast one, but you had some awfully good boys in those days and it took an extra good man to make your relay squad. If you find that you can do anything for the boy in boosting his wares I will follow through with Karl Klocz, but I would like to have a letter from you first.
