Coach Yost Reminisces



FIELDING H. YOST, "Grand Old Man" of University of Michigan athletics, who accompanied the Wolverine squad to Hotel Elkhart enroute to Notre Dame today, is shown here talking football with F. E. Hewitt, personnel manager of the Foster division, International Machine Tool Corp. Mr. Hewitt took post-graduate work at Michigan, after attending the University of Kansas, where he was a basketball and baseball player. Coach Yost had an unbeaten and untied football team at Kansas in 1899, before coaching at Michigan from 1901 to '23 and again in '25 and '26, later serving as athletic director. In his 25 years as Michigan coach he had 4 undefeated and untied teams, and produced a dozen All American players.
