Dear Betty Jeanne:

Thank you for your kind letter of August 10th. If your folks can send you about \$35.00 a month, and if you have a part-time job to pay a part of your expenses I see no reason why you should not be able to make it at K. U.

Of course, the initial expense is somewhat great. Your matriculation fee (payable but once) is \$10.00, the incidental fee, each semester, is \$25.00. Also there is a health fee of \$5.00 a semester, and the Activity fee of \$6.00 the first semester, \$2.75 the second semester. In addition, if you take laboratory courses, there will be a laboratory fee; and of course, your books.

If you do join a sorority it might be that you could get a secretarial or bookkeeping job in the sorority which would take care of part of your expenses.

I am leaving tomorrow morning for Louisville, Ky., for a few days, but will return in a week or so, and if you want to write me again I will be glad to hear from you.
