Dear Leighton:

What I had in mind some months ago was to have a combined write-up of the Big Six conference and the Missouri Valley conference, showing that the schools of both conferences resided in this area, and then in the rule book have a separate write-up of the Missouri Valley conference and also the Big Six conference, just as we have.

There is a very definite confusion over the United States concerning the Big Six and the Missouri Valley.

When I come to Des Moines this winter I will have a talk with you and we will work out something for next year.

Mr. Earl Falkenstien, secretary of the University of Kansas Physical Education Corporation, left a carbon copy of his letter of August 11 to you upon my desk. The booklet on basketball gotten out by Mr. W. A. Dill, publicity director for the University of Kansas, will give you the championships in basketball.

When I came here in 1919 I began to endeavor to set the house in order, and beginning in 1923 we have a definite year book of all sports showing the standing of each team from then on. I think you already wrote me for this, and doubtless where the championships begin in 1923 you recorded these from our record. This will bring your basketball up, but football and track championships are still being dug up.
