Dear Dr. Allen:

I have recently completed a survey of the medical supervision of candidates for High School Athletic teams as required by the organizations controlling athletics in the respective states. Most of the states do nothing about it. Others have, for the most part, an entirely inadequate and superficial medical inspection.

I am attempting, with the aid of a group of physicians who are familiar with the problems of Athletics, to formulate a suitable blank for the medical examination of High School Athletes. On the enclosed sheets I have listed the most common elements in the medical examination of Public School Boys, together with a scale for rating them.
