put in charge of this clean-up movement. Immediately, he solicited the cooperation of all varsity letter men in the university to assist him in discouraging booing and hissing to the limit.

So well did he handle the job that when the basketball game deciding the conference championship was played on our home court and the visiting team led in the scoring for most of the game, there was not a single act of discourtesy or razzing.

Our college officials, who are, for the most part, young professional men and businessmen of high type, should not be forced to suffer the humiliation of being outraged and mentally coerced by howling mobs, who have lost their sporting decency.
