


### MUSCLES OF THE SHOULDER-GIRDLE



### MOVEMENTS OF THE SHOULDER GIRDLE

Forward - Protraction

Backward - Retraction

Upward - Elevation

Downward - Depression

Combinations - Rotation

The shoulder is an enarthrodial (Ball and Socket) joint. The articulation is formed by the head of the humerus and the glenoid fossa.
