I will try to outline the nature of my inquiry some months ago.

I am interested in the organization of labor setups in different physical education departments about the State of Missouri.

I want to know:

- 1. If you do not have a labor foreman who is responsible for the marking of courts, fields, and play areas.
- 2. If the same workmen are responsible for the athletic department as well as the physical education department.
- 3. Who is responsible for equipment for the different physical education classes:
- 4. Who is responsible for keeping the building clean?
- 5. Who is responsible for keeping the grounds attractive?
- 6. How many men are needed in this type of work as outlined in the above two questions?

as to the nature of my inquiry - I am most interested in the policy of the University as to the organization of the above items.
