

Dear Doctor Allen:

We have your letter of June 30, and one or the other of us certainly must have been imbibing too freely, as I certainly was not in a normal condition if I wrote you that we had some new Drivers and Brassies in steel-shaft models at \$1.25. I have been unable to locate a copy of my letter of the 15th, but what I should have said was that we did have some of these at \$1.95. We just received an order the first of the week,however, from the Eastern Illinois State Teachers College, Charleston, Ill., for 35 Drivers and 35 Brassies, which has cleaned us out of these temporarily.

We have some very good new steel-shafted Spalding Spoons which we can give you at \$1.95 each, and we can give you the Andy Robertson model in new clubs at \$2.45 each in any quantity desired of Drivers, Brassies or Spoons. In irons we have a few good hickory-shafted models at from 75¢ to 95¢. We will be glad to make selection of anything you desire subject to approval.

We occasionally get a few used steel-shafted clubs which we sell at \$1.25, but they usually go out about as fast as they come in. We might be able to dig up two or three of these for you, and if so will send them subject to your approval.

We enclose our Golf sheet, and if you need any balls recommend some of our Repaint Practice Balls as being exceptional values.
