Dear Mr. King:

Will you kindly prepare for the Department of Physical Education one gallon of Osemer's Solution, the formula of which is as follows:

- Boric acid . . . . . 7 oz.
- Glycerine . . . . . 3 oz.
- Alcohol (grain) . . . . 27 oz.
- Phenol . . . . . 2 oz.
- Distilled water . . . . 89 oz.

Mix boric acid and glycerine in a paste before adding the phenol, alcohol and distilled water. We desire to use this as a wet antiseptic dressing.
