

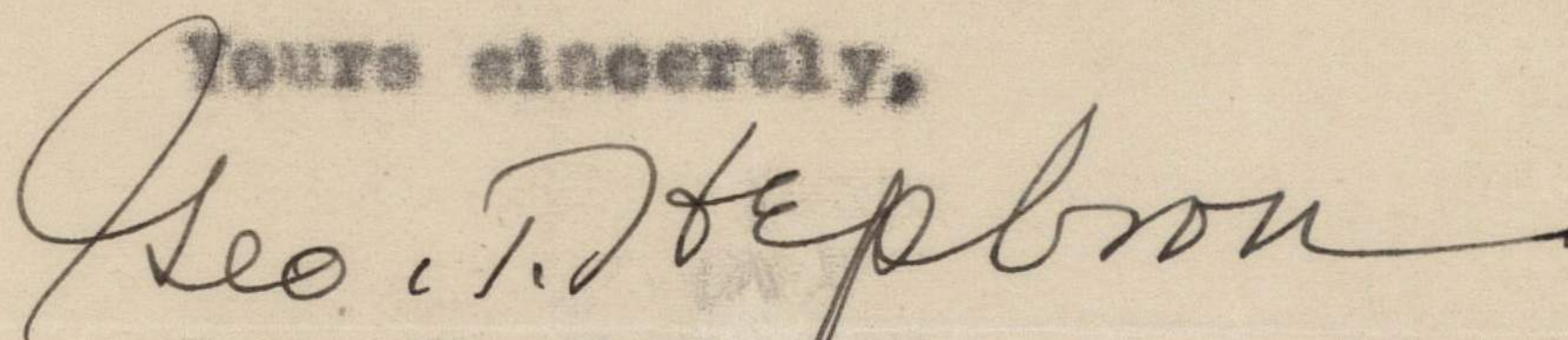

The idea was to bring this into harmony with the statement and the note of Section 10 to the effect that a player may pivot at the end of a legal dribble."
