I told him I knew that those people must be mistaken because all rubber shoes are rationed. Of course the football, baseball and track shoes are not because they have spikes in them, but that is a special dispensation.

I asked Bert Nash to call you so that you could tell him the straight of it. And I also wanted you to understand my situation. I am helping these people both in the Army and the Navy in any way that I can, but all the orders are handled through the regular military channels and that is where my function ceases. I told Dr. Nash that it was necessary in the beginning to have the ration coupon and if there has been any delay I assure you that it has not been my fault. I want you to get my position clearly.

I trust that there will be no great delay due to any misunderstanding that might have occurred.

There have been more inquiries on Push Balls and Push Ball Bladders during the past six months than probably for the last six years.


No, there is no hope of helping you out at this time but we will be glad to keep this matter in mind and whenever we find out Push Ball Bladders are again available we will surely let you know.

We have a large leather Push Ball, 6 feet in diameter, but the bladder has disintegrated and we are unable to replace it at the present time. Push Ball bladders require fresh, crude rubber, and I understand that the WPB does not permit the production of this item.

I know that with your close connection with Mr. Iseley you might get a tip-off when these bladders are going to be made again. I would appreciate this as a personal favor, as we need this pretty badly. Fresh, crude rubber is going from Japan to Russia, and then reshipped to the United States. Just how much of that we will get I don't know.

Dr. Frank W. Hurley, a dentist of Leonardville, Kansas, came in this morning with his son to have me examine his son's shoulder. The shoulder had been dislocated a number of times until it is very susceptible to dislocation at the slightest provocation when the arm is raised above the level of the shoulder joint.

I have recommended to him the brace that your firm has made for a number of people. I remember in particular Larry Smith, a son of Lawrence Smith of Smith-Grieves Publishing Company. The boy was then playing for Pembroke Country Day School. And then you made one for Early Chestnut's son, Lorraine.

In my book, "Better Basketball", the brace is described on pages 361-2-3.

I am sure that Dr. Hurley will want a brace like this made for his son. In some cases doubtless the school would pay for it, but I am sure that Dr. Hurley is willing to pay for the brace. However, I am wondering if you would be good enough to make him the school price on it since the boy will compete in all sports at Leonardville High School this next year. Mr. Lloyd Miller, the principal, wrote me regarding the boy, stating that he shows promise in athletics and that he is eager to participate in football and basketball.

I suggested that perhaps Dr. Hurley could drive in and have your firm take the measurements there, but Dr. Hurley was in a rush to get back to his practice and could not drive in today. Would it be possible for Frank Mandeville to write to Dr. Hurley or to Mr. Lloyd Miller, the principal, and let them know when he might be in the vicinity of Leonardville, so that he might take the measurements. I am sure that Mandy could make the measurements necessary for your man who makes the braces. I will appreciate this if you will write Dr. Hurley at your earliest convenience, making the necessary arrangements.


A lot of the trophies regularly in our line are no longer available - our stocks have been sold and they are not replaceable.

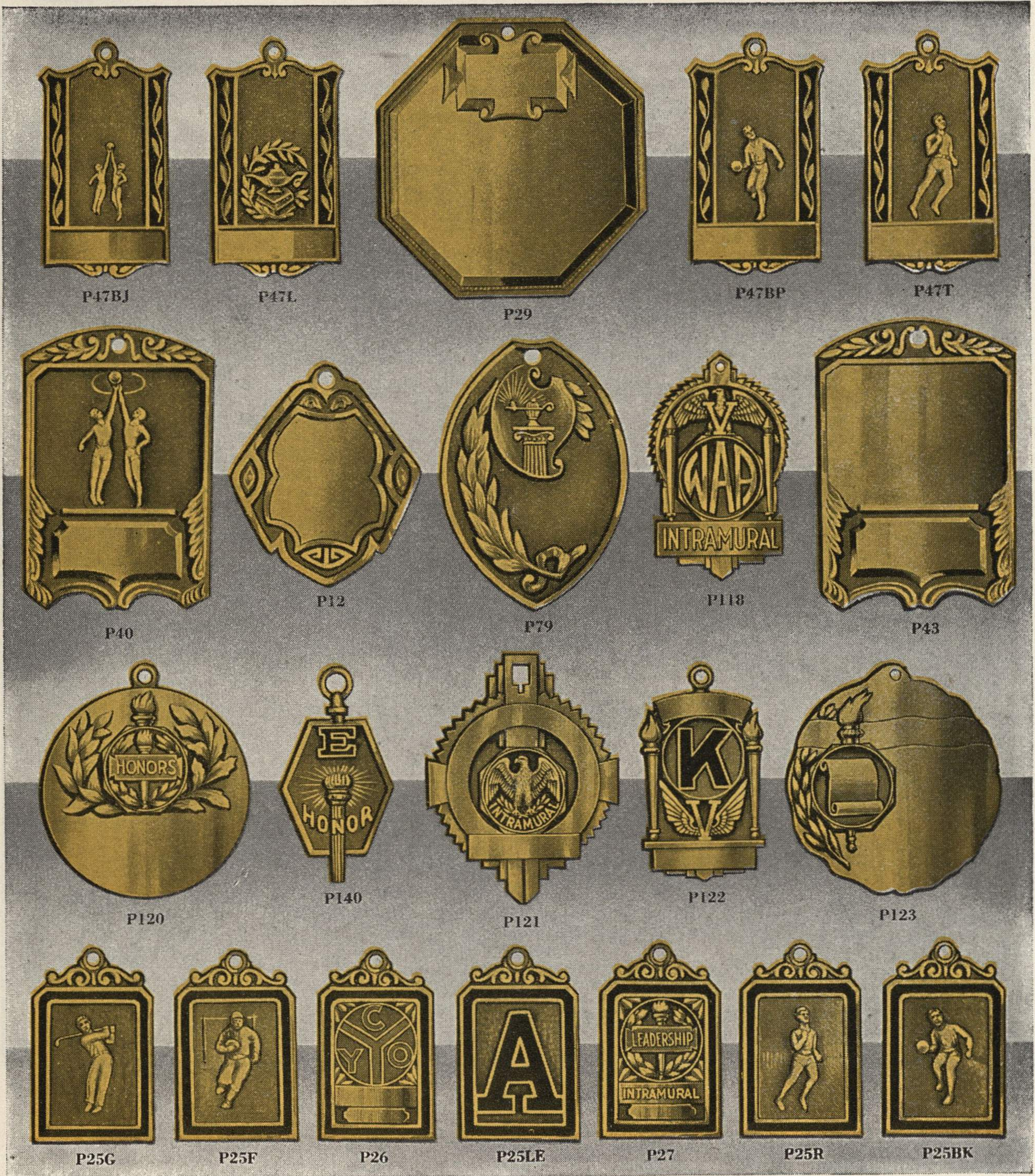
