In "Streamline Tennis" Miss Browne has drawn upon her wide experience as player and instructor. Turning aside from the outmoded method of calling attention to the faults of the beginner, she blazes a trail of directness to the goal of perfection. Her methods are positive, not negative. The academic methods of grip and stroke are presented in simplified form, as also employment of the variations of each in competition, while the chapters on stroking present some of the best explanatory diagrams that have as yet come from any player. Incidentally, and contrary to general opinion, Miss Browne believes that women are capable of successfully playing the net game, citing instances of where it has won for leading players, not to mention herself. Rich and fresh in its treatment of tennis strokes and tactics, Miss Browne has provided a volume that should also serve as an excellent textbook for teachers, particularly the closing chapter, "101 Questions and Answers," which contains many gems of information on play and technique.
