TO ALL MEMBERS

ARTICLE 6, SECTION 2, of the By-Laws of the Lawrence Country Club as amended October 4, 1929 reads as follows:

"The name of any member who shall fail to pay his club indebtedness within thirty days after bill is rendered, shall be posted on the bulletin board of the club together with the amount due. If such member shall fail to pay such indebtedness within thirty additional days he shall automatically cease to be entitled to any of the privileges of the club until such time as all arrears have been paid. The regular dues will accumulate during such time a member is not entitled to the privileges of the club. Should such indebtedness of any member accumulate to the amount of the regular dues for three months, the party so in arrears will automatically cease to be a member of the club."

The same Article and Section calls for the payment of dues in advance.

A continuing delinquent dues list of approximately \$600. has finally forced the Board to authorize, even under depression conditions, a strict compliance with the By-Laws. The provisions of the ByLaws above quoted will be enforced commencing on December 1, 1940.
