

parents shall be responsible for the junior members' conduct and indebtedness to the Club.

Junior membership shall terminate when the member becomes twenty-one years of age; after which such member may be granted the privileges of the Club until such member is twenty-three years of age, by paying one-half of the dues of a regular member.

When such a member becomes twenty-three years old he may within one year thereafter, upon application duly accepted as hereinbefore provided, become a regular or associate member.

Section 2f. Minor children of members under the age of ten must be accompanied by a member when visiting the Club house or grounds. If such minors desire the privileges of junior membership, their age and name must be registered with the secretary at the request of their parents.

Section 2g. A widowed mother of an unmarried member shall have the privileges of the Club. Unmarried members may also invite a guest of opposite sex to the Club social functions at any time.

Section 2h. Any member, except junior members, may invite guests, either men or women except special fete days or special fete nights, providing that no person, except as provided in Section 2g, whose residence is less than 10 miles of the Club property shall be a guest of the Club to exceed twice in one year.

Section 2i. Upon the written request of a member to the secretary a non-resident guest may be granted the privileges of the Club for a period of two weeks. An extension of one week's time may be granted to such a guest with the consent of the Board of Directors.

Section 2j. Candidates for full membership of the Club shall be proposed by three regular members and voted upon by the Board of Directors. The name of every candidate, his occupation, and place of business, with the name of his proposers, shall be posted in a conspicuous place in one of the rooms of the Club for at least two weeks before the ballot for his election shall be cast. A majority of the entire Board of Directors shall be necessary for the election.
