Our electric clock which we use in the auditorium for basketball games was made here by our electricians. It is operated from the scorer's desk. At the expiration of time there is a pistol which is attached and fired electrically from the clock left.

I am sorry that we do not have blue prints and specifications. As I remember, the clock cost about \$250.00.

We are now working on an electric score board to be placed above the basket at the other end of the court, but we are just in the midst of plans and designs so I can give you no information yet about that.
