The cranial part of the nervous is located in the head and acts as a receiver & involuntary nerve ~~flow~~ stimuli. The cerebros is the receiving center of automatic impulses. The central part of the nervous system is located in the spine. The autonomic N.S. consists of sympathetic & parasympathetic nerves. The autonomic sympathetic is thoracic-lumbar outflow. Parasympathetic is cranial-sacral outflow. Sympathetic goes 6-12 thoracic. The ganglia are arranged in ~~set~~ central, collateral + peripheral

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
