

Questions for a First Aid Examination

The time for all ten questions should be two hours.

1. What is meant by the Pasteur treatment? In what per cent of the cases is the use of it effective?
2. Discuss fully the treatment for snake-bites.
3. What are two points to be remembered in the treatment of any poiston-drug case?
4. Discuss symptoms and treatment for epileptic fits?
5. Tell what you know of carbon monoxide gas as a potent poison; where there are dangers of encountering it and how to prevent these dangers.
6. Give treatment of wounds when bleeding is severe. How would you treat wounds when bleeding is not severe?
7. Discuss what you know of the use of the tourniquet. Should it be used if bleeding can be otherwise checked? Why not?
8. Outline procedure for the rescue of a victim from contact with an electric wire. Outline treatment of such a victim.
9. In cases of skull fracture or concussion what treatment should be followed by the first-aider until the physician arrives?
10. Why should a first-aider never wash a wound with soap and water?
