Dear Louie:

I am answering your letter of December 15 relative to the assignment of basketball officials in which Kansas is concerned. I had a letter from Quigley dated December 16 cancelling the January 10, 14, 20 and 23 dates in which Kansas is concerned.

In looking over my sheet I have O'Sullivan in second choice in the Kansas State game on January 10, and also in the Nebraska game at Lincoln on January 14. I presume that it was impossible to get O'Sullivan in these games. You will notice that on January 10 Kansas State is to come to Lawrence, and Quigley and Volz were to work the game. We would like to have O'Sullivan or Peters for this game on the 10th.

On the 14th at Lincoln, we had Duvall listed fifth. I am wondering if you couldn't get O'Sullivan to work that game at Lincoln.

For the game with Missouri at Lawrence on January 18, Peters to replace Cochrane is satisfactory, to work with Volz.

On January 20 when Kansas plays at Kansas State why not O'Sullivan, Carroll, Peters or Astle?

For our game with you at your place Quigley and Has-Brouck were to work. I am wondering about O'Sullivan or Parke Carroll. Personally, I would much prefer Mutt Volz, or any of them. Why cannot we get Volz to replace Quigley?

When I chose Quigley I did not worry about the other officials, but with Quigley out of it this changes the set up quite a bit, because Quigley generally dominates the games.

Also, I am wondering if Quigley accepted the date of February 14. I would prefer him to fill Cochrane's date.
