

When I wrote Dan Ferris, Frederick Rubien and Avery Brundage about basketball being in the Olympics they all thought that nobody played basketball except in the United States. It just emphasized to me how poorly informed some people are on many angles that they should know about. We could sell it for a lesser price than the other book, say \$2.00, and use all of the material we have, which would cut the cost materially, and then add some other very important football pictures. The book would go into most of the high schools because the coaches know so little about the training of their boys.

You will remember I discussed this with you once before, but I would like to have your reaction to it at present. Of course, this is for future consumption.
