I am very sorry that we just haven't anyone to suggest for the vacancy at Battle Creek. Most of the boys are going into the physical education programs under the direction of Gene Tunney in the Navy, or in the Army, or Army mechanics. I have talked to Ralph Miller, and a number of other boys, and they are all going into these jobs, or in civilian jobs until they are drafted.

Where they can enlist, they are doing that. All the boys are looking toward the service. I don't know what the schools will do for teachers - we are in the same fix here with our faculty.

I am just hastening off to a meeting, and will write you more fully some time later. I do appreciate your writing me and am sorry that I have no one to suggest.
