Thank you for your kind letter of October 31. We do appreciate the effort you made to deliver the towels to us as promptly as possible, and it helped to relieve a very critical situation here.

There is one thing, Mr. McArthur, that I want to tell you about. The towels don't seem to absorb the moisture very readily. They seem to have some sort of pulpy material in them. I am not trying to analyze the texture of the towels, but only stating what a number of our people have said - that they do not absorb the moisture. Perhaps repeated launderings will take care of that.
