I am addressing you three gentlemen in regard to the meeting of the National College Basketball Officials of your district at the time of the meeting of the National Association of Basketball Coaches, the National Rules Committee, and the National Collegiate play-off. I am wondering if you have done anything toward inviting the officials of the different collegiate districts to meet with you at that time. It will be a perfectly natural and easy thing to get all of the officials of the country in here at that time.

The National Basketball Coaches Association is planning to contribute from their funds one dollar per member for a \$1.65 admission ticket to the National Collegiate A. A. Championship finals which will be played on March 30.

Will you gentlemen not have a huddle and talk to the responsible groups in officiating so that we can have a dignified meeting of this group at the time the other bodies are in session?

Always in the past at our Rules meeting we have the Basketball Coaches Association meet and make a recommendation to the Rules body. The Rules Body also deliberates on suggestions made by the Officials Association as thoroughly as they deliberate on the suggestions of the Coaches Association.

I believe this time there is a great opportunity for the Officials Association in this section to make itself prominently and definitely felt. May I hear from you as to your progress? I desire to be mutually cooperative.
