- 7. Each member of the squad of fifteen will be given two complimentary tickets for each night. Participant passes and complimentary tickets will be delivered to you upon arrival.
- 8. Towel service will be available at the Coliseum where your games will be played.
  - 9. You may practice on the Coliseum floor on the morning of March 20. Other events prevent earlier use of the Coliseum for basketball.
