Part II. 7(a)(1) Depends on type of molded ball.

"Suggest that rule be added -- During a time out or between quarters officials to report at scorers table to check players entering game.

"Reason - I have witnessed three tech. fouls, this year, called because player entering game did not notice officials standing down at one of court and walked over to teammates before reporting. This is especially true in high school play where players are over-anxious to enter game, and I feel that adding above rule will be a great aid to the high school players. I have seen officials sit down along sideline and player enter game and have tech. foul called for not reporting. Personally I feel that in some cases the official has been the one at fault and should not charge player with tech. foul."

\*Part II. (9) I favor return to use of center jump with rotation, providing two officials are employed. With only one man, it is impossible to get all the jostling around the center jump circle.
