

5. To further at all times the best interests and well-being of the game of basketball, and to maintain it in its proper plane in the scheme of education.

ARTICLE III

Membership

Section 1. There shall be three (3) classes of membership: Active, allied, and honorary.

Section 2. Coaches from institutions which offer a four year baccalaureate degree and who are actively engaged in the profession of basketball coaching shall be eligible for active membership.

Section 3. Individuals who have been associated with basketball coaching at any institution of learning, including junior colleges, normal schools, high schools, and preparatory schools; former active members who are no longer actively engaged in or directly associated with the profession of basketball coaching; and individuals who are interested in the well-being of the game and in the attainment of the objects and purposes of this Association, as set forth in Article II hereof, shall be eligible for allied membership.

Section 4. Any individual nominated by the Membership Committee and elected by a two-thirds vote of active members present at the annual meeting shall be eligible for honorary membership and, upon acceptance, shall be so enrolled.

Section 5. All members shall have the privilege of the floor at meetings of the Association, but the privilege of voting at such meetings shall be exercised only by active members.
