Please let me hear from you at your earliest convenience.

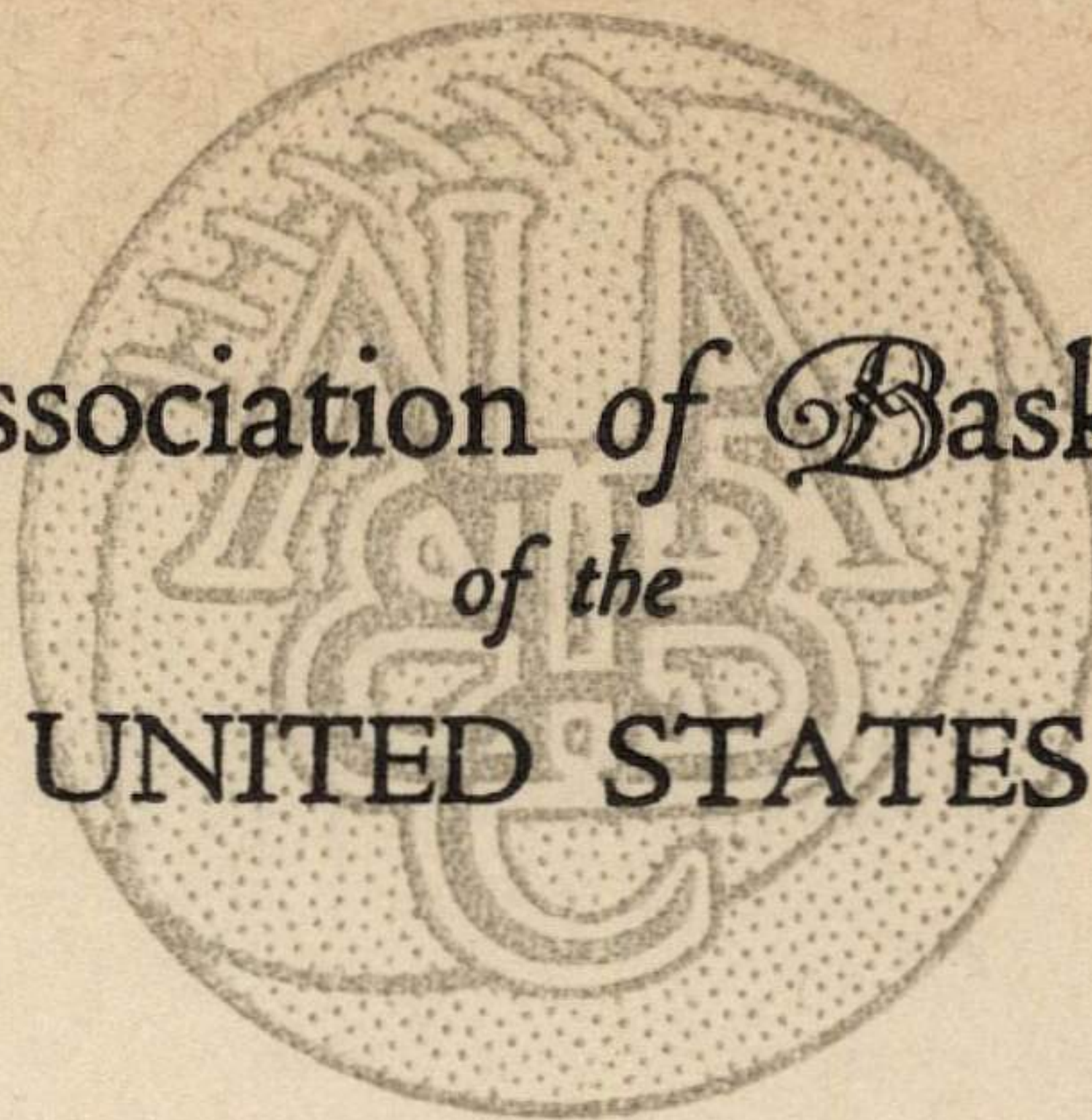
