Constitution of the National Association of the Basketball Coaches of the United States

The name of this organization shall be The National Association of Basketball Coaches of the United States

This association is organized by a representative group of basketball coaches and is affiliated with the National Athletic Association with their approval.

The purpose of this association shall be:
1. To dignify the basketball coaching profession.
2. To elevate the game to its proper place in the scheme of education.
3. To foster and encourage a better understanding between basketball coaches of the various sections of the United States.
4. To maintain even to a greater degree the standards of sportsmanship as outlined in the basketball code.

Section I. There shall be three classes of membership: Active, Allied, and Honorary.

Section II. Active Membership. Only such coaches shall be eligible for Active Membership as are actively engaged in (or directly associated with) the profession of basketball coaching, and are otherwise acceptable to the organization.

Section III. Active Voting Membership. Each Active Membership shall be in the name of an individual and an institution and only such institutions shall be eligible for membership as are members in good standing of the National Athletic Association.

Section IV. Allied Membership. Any individual who has been associated with basketball coaching for three or more years may be eligible for an Allied Membership, whether or not he is at the time actively engaged in coaching. Members who have been active and who are no longer associated with the institution through which they were active are eligible for this classification. Prospective school coaches are also eligible.

Section V. Honorary Membership. Honorary members shall be elected to the membership at the pleasure of the association upon the third vote of the Active Membership.

Classification of Members

Section I. Application. Each applicant for any class of membership shall sign an application blank stating his name and institution to become a member of the Association and to advance its best
