My dear Schaby:

I just returned from Salt Lake City and am answering your fine letter of the 23d inst. I shall be very happy to appoint McLaughry of Brown University, in the first district. The other appointments for the various districts have been agreed upon, with the exception of the eighth district. For the eighth district, I shall appoint E. L. Romney, Utah Agricultural College, Logan, Utah.

I find that Armstrong is not coaching basketball there the next year. They have a new man there named Peterson, an old Utah man. Romney is coaching basketball at Utah Agricultural College at Logan, so of course that makes him eligible, and I find that he has a very large and free acquaintance with the coaches on the coast. So I believe that will be a happy selection.

We will leave E. J. Marti of the University of Nevada, Reno, on the Program committee. Yes, Karl Schlademan is coaching varsity basketball at Washington State College, Pullman Washington.

I am glad to know that you have written the four members of the Board of Trustees. I shall be happy to learn what their response is. I hope you get acceptances from each of these men.

I have received letters from some coaches now desiring membership. Godfrey, at Minnesota, wrote me last week. I will send you his letter as soon as I get through my mass of correspondence, together with my reply to him.

I believe you misunderstood what I meant by
