He will contact your Dr. Phat Nelson and any other that you deem advisable toward interesting this boy in the University of Kansas. It is nice of you to do this dan, and I certainly appreciate it.

When better and more enthusiastic alumni are made they wont make them any better than our Dan Bolen. I certainly enjoyed my visit with you upon the occasion of my last visit to Salina.
